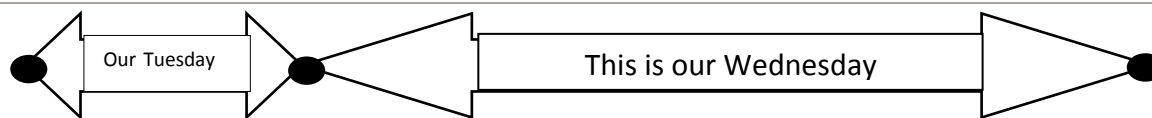

1. "Sabbath" is not always on Saturday (e.g. 1st Day of Unleavened Bread is High Sabbath).
2. "Passover" is an event which occurs at Midnight.
3. The daily morning sacrifice was made at the 3rd hour (9:00 am) Jesus was crucified the 3rd hour.
4. The daily evening sacrifice was made at the 9th hour (3:00 pm) Jesus gave up the Ghost at the 9th hour.
5. According to Scripture, evening is 12 hours, morning is 12 hours

Note the "2nd evening" "times" are often called watches, which correspond to the first and second watches [e.g., 1st watch (between 6 pm and 9 pm), 2nd watch (between 9 pm and 12 MN), 3rd watch (between 12MN and 3 am), and 4th watch (between 3 am and 6 am)].

Other important passages are Ex. 12:1-29, Lev. 23:1-16
