## TWELVE CHARACTERISTICS OF UNBELIEF

- 1. Unbelief dulls the spiritual senses, Hebrews 3:7-8 (deaf ears and blind hearts).
- 2. Unbelief makes one disregard the person and work of Christ, Hebrews 3:9.
- 3. Unbelief makes one displease (disobey) God, Hebrews 3:10.
- 4. Unbelief causes restlessness, Hebrews 3:11.
- 5. Unbelief is a COMBINATION of ONE sin (unbelief), human good and evil. (None of these are confessed as personal sin). Hebrews 3:12.
- 6. Unbelief makes one deceitful (seductive) Hebrews 3:13.
- 7. Unbelief makes one lose his confidence, Hebrews 3:14.
- 8. Unbelief is characterized by grumbling, Hebrews 3:15.
- 9. Unbelief ensnares the MAJORITY of believers, Heb 3:16.
- 10. Unbelief for the MAJORITY of believers is a WAY OF LIFE and leads one to the sin unto death, Hebrews 3:17.
- 11. Unbelief is characterized by being UNPERSUADEABLE and UNTEACHABLE, Hebrews 3:18.
- 12. Unbelief ultimately knocked the over 20 crowd out of growth, maturity and rewards, Hebrews 3:19. All they got was death!

<u>A believer is never to stop believing</u>! This is the only way Adam's sin of unbeliefdisobedience is handled. One confesses his personal sins when out of fellowship, and then stays in fellowship and grows to maturity, and stays mature by grace.
